#### PROGRAMME

The awareness workshop aims to present the transboundary CAMP Otranto project in which to involve the possible stakeholders for the implementation of the project activities.

The event is closely linked to the **Individual Action (IA) No. 1** - ICZM management system and audit scheme (ICZM SAS), which provides for the establishment and implementation of an ICZM management and audit system (ICZM SAS), in order to evaluate and support relevant initiatives related to ICZM at the local level. The activity is part of the measures to increase the efficiency and sustainability of activities in the Mediterranean area. The IA foresees the identification of a selected number of local activities where to test the ICZM SAS. An area of interest is the **sustainable fishing**, with the collaboration of fishermen in the collection of marine litters; sustainable fishing on the model adopted in the Marine Protected Area of Torre Guaceto, to be extended to other coastal areas.

The operational part involves the analysis of the collection of a sample of marine litter, with the support of the scientific evaluation of universities and research centres; the institutional response to the problem of litter delivery (collection point and dedicated infrastructure), and the management of litter by category; the best practices of protected areas; and the monitoring and control of the Harbour Offices/Coast Guard.
